DISTRIBUTION SHIFT

ARRIVE by 4:30pm

MEMBERS will arrive for pick-up after 5pm.

SIGN-IN

Ask the members to sign-in and direct them accordingly to the full or partial share boxes, depending on their type of farm share. Check to see if they also pick up a bread or meat/egg share that particular week and if so, make sure they pick up those shares as well.

REMIND

Bread and Meat/ Egg shares will alternate each week. Please double check that members pick up their bread and/or meat/egg shares. Any **FORGOTTEN** shares of bread, meat, or eggs will not be held for a later pick-up date. We apologize for any inconvenience.

KITCHEN USE AND SAMPLING

New this year to City pickup, the City Distribution Crew will routinely prepare items for sampling featuring the produce of the week. Recipes will be displayed with the dishes to alert anyone with food allergies of unknown ingredients. Anyone wishing to participate in food preparation should contact Stacey Cook. Some minimal clean up work maybe asked of the shift workers to ensure we leave Bad Seed as tidy as we find it.

CLOSING

Usually there will be a number of leftover vegetables at the end of the shift. The remaining vegetables may be claimed by the workers, or left for Brooke's Friday market. Any forgotten bread or meat should go home with the workers

FORGOTTEN SHARES & MISSED PICK-UPS

If arrangements have been made with Stacey or Jes regarding any anticipated missed pick-ups, one of these core members will set that particular share, including any bread or meat & eggs, aside for Friday. On Friday, Bad Seed has a Farmer's Market from 4:30 until 9pm. During this time, those rescheduled pick-ups may procure their shares.
